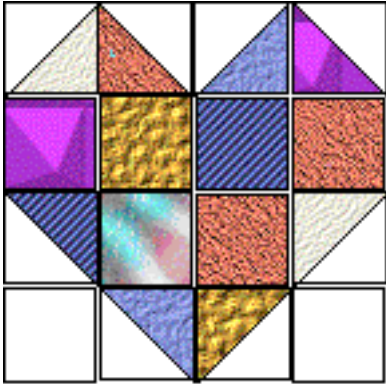


## 12" Scrappy Hearts (directions are for 5 blocks)



Background fabric –

Cut 3 strips,  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x 42"

Cut 10  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from one of the strips

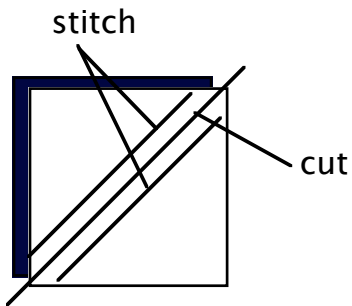
Cut 20  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Other fabrics –

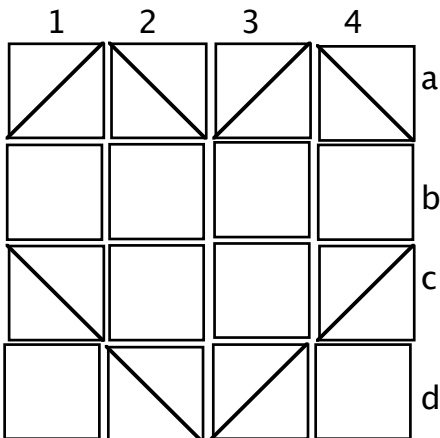
Cut  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " strips of each fabric – use between 5 and 10 different ones

Then, cut 20  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Cut 30  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from the rest of the strips



Pair one background  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square with one other  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " fabric square, right sides together. On the light side, draw the diagonal. Draw lines  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the diagonal. Stitch a thread width inside the  $\frac{1}{4}$ " lines. Cut apart on the diagonal. Press seams to dark. Square up to make 40  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " half square triangles .



Lay out all the squares to be sure of the correct placement. Stack the units of column 2 on top of the units of column 1, right sides together, then sew, keeping the chain of thread between the units. Add the units of column 3, then column 4, leaving all the threads between the columns.

Press so you have opposing seams.

Match seams of rows a and b. Stitch.

Match seams of rows c and b. Stitch.

Match seams of rows d and c. Stitch.

Press.

Your scrappy hearts should measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " each, if not, square them up!

Instead of the four center blocks, you could print a Foto onto Fabric, cutting it  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square, then bordering it with a dark contrasting fabric.
